### ABOUT THE POSITION:

As an Event Host at Roberta's Society, you are first and foremost the host - a visible, energetic and welcoming presence throughout the entire guest journey.

You are on the floor, in the middle of the action, setting the tone, engaging guests and making sure everyone feels included and part of the experience. **You don't just help run events - you bring them to life.**

At the same time, you take an active role in the practical execution. From setup to breakdown, you are hands-on, solution-oriented and ready to step in wherever needed to ensure a smooth and seamless event.

You will work closely with the events, bar and front-of-house teams, acting as the link between operations and guest experience - always with a strong focus on atmosphere, flow and quality.

### YOUR RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Act as a visible and engaging host during events, welcoming guests and creating a warm, inclusive atmosphere
- Take ownership of the guest experience in real time, ensuring energy, flow and high satisfaction throughout the event
- Facilitate and support live event execution (introductions, transitions, guest interaction and overall atmosphere)
- Be a go-to person during events for guests, artists and collaborators
- Assist with setup and breakdown of events (furniture, logistics and basic operational tasks)
- Take part in hands-on floor tasks during and after events (clearing glasses, cleaning, resetting spaces, etc.)
- Help maintain a clean, welcoming and well-functioning environment throughout the event
- Support community dinners, bar shifts, live music, workshops and other cultural events
- Work closely with bar and front-of-house teams to ensure smooth flow and a seamless guest experience
- Engage with guests and gather feedback directly, contributing to continuous improvement
- Work proactively and help solve challenges on the spot during live events
- Represent Roberta's Society's culture, values and energy in every guest interaction
- Occasionally support light administrative tasks such as simple coordination or confirmations

- Thrive in a front-facing role and feel comfortable being “on” in a social environment
- Are naturally outgoing, welcoming and confident engaging with new people
- Have a strong sense of atmosphere and know how to read and influence a room
- Are hands-on and proactive - you take initiative and are never too fine for any task - whether it's hosting, moving tables, clearing glasses or jumping in where needed.
- Can balance operational awareness with genuine guest presence
- Are flexible and enjoy working in a dynamic environment with varying shifts
- Have experience in hospitality, events or hosting (a plus, not a requirement)
- Have good communication skills and are fluent in both spoken and written Danish and English
